He is a Senior Consultant in the Department of Haematology in SGH. In addition, A/Prof Goh is the Acting Chairman of the Division of Research, the Director of the Clinical Trials Resource Centre and the Office of Translational Medicine Oversight in SGH.

A/Prof Goh has always been particularly keen in research and has research initiatives in various aspects of the haematological field. Dr. Goh's clinical interests includes various haematologic malignancies such as leukemias, lymphomas and multiple myeloma and in stem cell transplantation . He has a special interest in chronic myeloid leukemias as well as conducting early phase clinical trials. He has been involved in numerous pivotal registration trials and First in Human trials. Dr Goh is actively involved in basic research to treat leukemias using immunotherapy and the use of regulatory T cells to induce tolerance in stem cell transplantation. Much of his efforts have focused on translating invaluable knowledge gleaned from bench research into the clinic. He has been recipient of more than S\$5 million in research grants.

He is an Adjunct Associate Professor at Duke–NUS Graduate Medical School and Clinical Senior Lecturer at the National University Hospital.
