

Professor Ren Ee Chee is a Scientist at A*STAR. He is currently the Principal Investigator of Singapore Immunology Network SiGN since 2007. Prof Ren obtained his PhD in 1981 and has been concurrently Assoc Professor at the Department of Microbiology, Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, NUS.
